

#### Flat Back

Easy and recommended method.


Just use a silicone called SIKA FLEX (very strong glue available at hardware's)) and some sticky tape or a couple of sticks to hold plaque up overnight.

Suitable for installation on a flat surface



#### Lugs with Studs

Suitable for installation on a rough, angled or elevated surface.




#### Studs with Bolts

Suitable for concealed installation on bench seats.



## <u>Screws</u>


Only suitable for small plaques, usually used for installation on trees and timber seats. (Visible from front)



## Straight Lugs


Suitable for small plaques. Installation on angled surface.


# Angled Bracket

Suitable for niche walls.




#### Straight Bracket
